Welcome to Richmond-Wayne County, Indiana, where you'll experience an incredible community spirit. We're full of passionate locals who are proud to call this area "home," and who want to share their stories—and county—with you.

It's here you'll walk the same historic neighborhoods where recording stars like Hoagy Carmichael and Louis Armstrong spent time between recording sessions at the former Gennett Recording Studio. You'll see and experience art in a way that's only found in Wayne County—from more than 80 larger-than-life murals, to a world-class art museum. You'll visit artisans and watch them create beautiful works of art, including many that are sold worldwide. You'll experience first-hand what's been called the "Grand Central Station of the Underground Railroad" where nearly 2,000 fugitive slaves were protected and ushered north to freedom.

You'll spend days exploring our famous Antique Alley. A destination unto itself, this trail rambles through historic and scenic towns with a variety of small and large antique shops and malls, offering more than 1,200 antique dealers along two loop trails. More great shopping awaits you at our boutiques and specialty shops.

Foodies will love our culinary scene—from quaint coffee shops in historically-preserved buildings, to acclaimed fine dining in a grand old home. There's renowned BBQ in a pre-Civil War firehouse, and a homemade ice cream parlor that was featured on national television. From international flavors to Indiana's second oldest continuously-running tavern, it's easy to eat and drink your way through Wayne County.

There's an environmental passion in Wayne County, and you'll see it just about everywhere you look. In fact, the sustainable Cope Environmental Center was built to meet the "Living Building Challenge," a certification program so stringent in its requirements that only a few buildings around the world have qualified for the highest level. Our 466-acre arboretum has ponds, fields, and wetlands with 16 miles of hiking and biking trails and educational opportunities—all free to the public. A big part of the Cardinal Greenway, Indiana's longest rail-to-trail covering 62 miles, runs through Wayne County, and is a big draw for hikers and bikers.

Shopping



She was wandering through the antique store when she was stopped short by a neon Margaritaville sign.

“Perfect,” she said to herself, her Margaritaville-crazed son in mind. She snapped a cell phone photo, not quite ready to buy. A couple months went by. She’d looked at that photo dozens of times; finally, she called the antique store. It still had one sign. Her son found it under his Christmas tree.

That’s how it goes sometimes along eastern Indiana’s **Antique Alley**. More often than not, however, it’s an instant purchase. Something the buyer had always wanted—or didn’t know he wanted until he saw it.

ANTIQUE ALLEY TRAILS



Unleash your design inspiration as you embark on a treasure hunt with your closest friends. Antique Alley is a hotbed of vintage finds and is one of Indiana's most diverse antique destinations. Two different trails will guide you to more than 1,200 antique dealers offering a plethora of fun finds. Don't miss historic Cambridge City, the hub of Antique Alley, with more than ten distinctive shops and malls within a two-block area. Plan an overnight stay, because just one day isn't enough to uncover all the hidden treasures.



The antique stores here pair knowledgeable dealers with a passion for their profession. Today's shops are bright, clean and spacious with items displayed

in charming vignettes. Some pieces sell for hundreds—even thousands—of dollars, others for just a couple bucks.

While some antique stores own the merchandise, many offer space to individual vendors who set up their own displays and decide prices. The store provides the location and takes care of shoppers. Some stores do both.

Beth Leisure has been in Cambridge City for 20 years. "I have something for everyone," she says, because "almost everybody collects something."

"People coming from near and far don't even believe our prices," Leisure says.

dealers call eastern Indiana their "honey pot."

Cambridge City's **Building 125** is actually four separate and spacious buildings open from one to another inside. It's got both antiques and reproductions in furniture, primitives, and quilts, plus small items that include note cards, linens, and candles. "I just want to attract a little bit of everybody," says owner Norma Bertsch.

Wheeler's Antiques in Centerville started the local antique craze in 1970. "My husband and I both liked antiques and the house got too full, so it was time to open shop," says owner Sue Wheeler. A widow, she now shares the business with her son, Scott. "We like to find something unusual, something you don't see just everywhere. I tried to pare down but I love finding and I love buying."

The business has always had two buildings across the street from one another. Sue Wheeler handles the shop with glassware, paintings, and other more delicate items. Bigger items that include toys, signs, and furniture are in the other building, which Scott Wheeler runs. "My dad's theory was that if one side of the street burned down, we'd still open up the next day," he says.

The **Centerville Antique Mall**, is the largest facility along Antique Alley. It offers merchandise from many vendors ranging from small jewelry pieces to huge tractors.



Just across the state line in the quaint village of New Paris, Ohio, the **New Paris Antique Mall** offers four floors of unique antiques and collectibles, all under one roof.

Yes, antiques are big here. But there's more.

Boutique shopping beckons at **Luxe Lizzies**, a retail space in the Loft in Richmond's Depot District. Luxe Lizzies offers clothing and accessories with a young-ish vibe.

Down the street is **O’Onda Gallery & Gifts**, offering international fair trade/local artisans/products representing special causes. “Where you purchase with purpose,” owner Melinda Wilson says. After several visits to Mozambique, she named her shop O’Onda, Portuguese for wave. “With everything you purchase here, it’s like the ripples of a wave,” she says. “You’re touching lives. You’re supporting the artists, and their communities, ...”

Downtown Richmond is also home to **Esmond’s Shoes**, owned and operated by the same local family since 1950. They pride themselves in not only offering a great variety of quality footwear, but also in providing real, honest in-store service to their customers.

Ply Fiber Arts offers classes and supplies for knitting, crocheting, and weaving. Its 2018 move to a larger building provided space for workshops; pottery wheels are available. The former yarn shop became **Spoke Easy Bike Shop**.

The **Warm Glow Candle** outlet on I-70 is a must for not only candles—they still make their signature “lumpy, bumpy handmade candles”—but also home accent pieces.



Fountain Acres Amish Market

on U.S. 27 (the Quaker Trace) offers food samples aplenty—local produce, freshly baked goods, bulk

foods—as well as outdoor furniture. Shoppers rave about their deli sandwiches, which they often enjoy at the picnic tables outdoors.

Besides antiques, Centerville is also home to **The Village Forager** where you can shop for unique gift items, home décor, and more while sipping on your favorite hot beverage at the coffee bar.

Arts & Culture



Art is big here. Huge, even. Sometimes two or three stories tall and visible from blocks away.

More than 80 towering illustrations chronicle Wayne County's history, all done as murals, and celebrated on the **Murals' Trail**. Among the muralists is Pamela Bliss, who not only painted numerous murals in Wayne County and other Indiana spots, but also created a competition which brought additional art to Wayne County. "Not everyone goes to an art museum," she says. "This is something the common person sees every day. It's larger than life so it pulls you in."

Richmond and Wayne County are teeming with vibrant local art. Here you'll find historic buildings blanketed with colorful murals beaming with artistic expression created by passionate mural artists. From hidden alleyways to busy streets, Wayne County's murals define and capture the beauty, history and culture of the community. As you meander throughout the county, be on the lookout as more than 80 murals await you. There is a mural for every artistic palette from historical to whimsical and everything in between.



Two murals offer a striking example conveying the region's ties to the Underground Railroad. In Fountain City, the story unfolds at the **Levi &**

Catharine Coffin State Historic Site. Here is the 1839 Coffin house with its hiding room, cellar well, and wagon with hidden compartment, all used by the Coffins in helping more than 2,000 freedom seekers escape slavery. Other murals commemorate Richmond's recording heritage with Hoagy Carmichael, Louis Armstrong, Bix Beiderbecke and more.

Remnants of the **Levi & Catharine Coffin State Historic Site** buildings and its place in history as the cradle of recorded jazz, country, gospel, and blues are in **Whitewater Gorge Park.** So too is the musicians' Walk of Fame.

Another piece of public art is the **Madonna of the Trail** in Glen Miller Park in Richmond. It's along the National Road (U.S. 40), America's first highway. In the 1830s,

more than 200 wagons passed through every day, heading west. Some stayed, making Wayne County the most populous county in Indiana for a while.

Families going westward first went through Richmond, and then through Centerville where because of economic success, led to the narrowing of the roads that allowed residents to build additional rooms onto the front of their homes. Archways were erected between the brick rowhouses to give access to the rear of the buildings. Five of the original nine still exist.

Visitors to Centerville often stop at **Scott Shafer's studio** to watch him create functional pieces of stoneware, from large decorative bowls and vases to everyday plates and mugs, on his potter's wheel. "I try to make it real and honest," Shafer says. "I like every aspect of the process, from mixing the clay to selling the pots."

Overbeck Pottery can be found at the **Museum of Overbeck Art Pottery** in Cambridge City. Educated in the arts, the Overbeck sisters started creating their unique pottery in 1911, and continued

for more than 40 years. Many of the pieces are small, whimsical figurines. The value of the pottery has increased dramatically in recent decades. Librarian Dale Scott says, "They gave a lot away. One piece here was bought at a garage sale for \$5—now worth \$40,000."

Overbeck pieces are also at the **Richmond Art Museum**. The focus of the museum is on American art, particularly Hoosier. "In the early 1900s Richmond, Indiana had a group of artists whose interest in fostering art in their community made an authentic



contribution to the history of art in America. Richmond became an important center for art, a place that nourished and inspired artists," says director Shaun Dingwerth.

More recent galleries and an outdoor sculpture park are on the campuses of Earlham College and Indiana University East. Nearby, Bill and Jeanne Magaw, known as **The Magaws of Boston** (Indiana), have been creating contemporary kinetic sculptures in their country studio since 1970. Many brightly colored pieces have involved water; others are powered by wind. Other shops

offer classes and supplies for creating art. Ply Fiber Arts focuses on knitting, crocheting, and weaving. The hands-on interactive **Paint the Towne** art studio has classes on bisque pottery, acrylic painting, glass art, mixed media —sometimes as wine parties. "I wanted a place where people could come to experience art," says owner Maria Haber.

The first high school orchestra in the nation was in Richmond. Today, national and international musical performances are offered at the **Civic Hall Performing Arts Center** and **Earlham College**. The **Richmond Symphony Orchestra**, with origins since 1908, is one of the smallest U.S. communities to have a professional symphony orchestra.

Blues music is showcased at the **Firehouse BBQ & Blues** on weekends, recalls Richmond's recording history. The revitalized

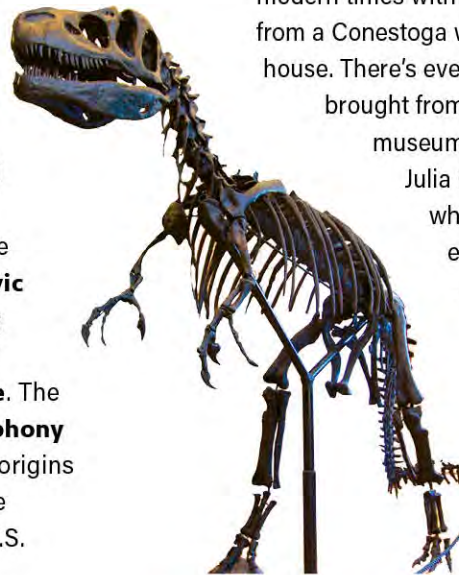

area of **Richmond's Historic Depot District** has become the "in" place to be, encompassing restaurants, a coffee bar, an ice cream parlor, shoppes, and the **Model T Museum**.

Additional early cars that were manufactured in Richmond are at the **Wayne County Historical Museum**. The museum is a unique repository of local history from early pioneer life into modern times with items ranging from a Conestoga wagon to a doll house. There's even a mummy,

brought from Egypt by museums founder Julia Meek Gaar, who traveled extensively around the world and brought her findings home where they are exhibited. A second mummy is in the free

Here are skeletons of a mastodon, giant beaver, interactive stations for youngsters, a planetarium, an extremely popular exhibit that includes live reptiles are among the museums offerings. Wayne County's first fairy home appeared at the Joseph Moore Museum in 2012. Now more than 40 fairy sites are available, sometimes in hidden spots, on the **Enchanted Fairy Trail**.

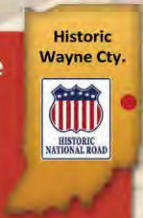

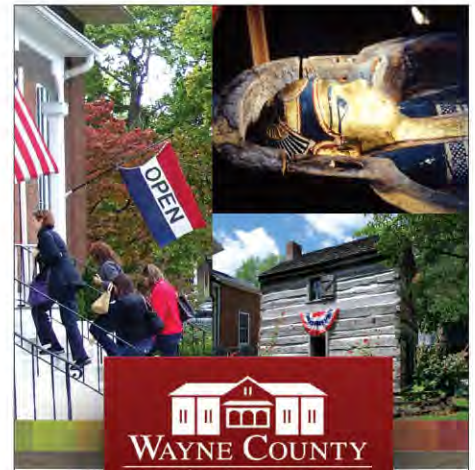

With two world-class environmental centers and a variety of trails, Wayne County's mantra could well be "take a hike." Meant in the most positive way, for a profusion of physical, mental and spiritual reasons.

With 466 acres, **Hayes Arboretum** offers hiking trails, ponds, fields, wetlands and an Indian Mound. It has three percent of the state's old growth forest plus acres of reforested land. Four generations of the Hayes family have worked this land, carrying on Stanley Hayes' commitment to not only preserve and protect nature but also share

it with the public through recreation and education, having the foresight to guarantee its future by creating a foundation in 1959.

“Native trees and reforestation—that was his passion, his hobby,” says great-grandson Steve Hayes Jr. “He wanted more people to have his love of reforestation.”

For this arboretum, native plant material from the Whitewater River Valley, a long educational history, and environmental stewardship. “People come here to learn—we’re definitely an educational facility—and to experience nature. We’re as much a part about the indoors as we are the outdoors,” Hayes says.



a meditation hike, a Native American history hike, children’s outdoor playscape, butterfly garden, nature center, and history museum.

Education is big, with classes and day camps for pre-schoolers through adults. Woodcarving is popular; beginners start by carving a bar of soap.

The main entrance is open 9 a.m.-5 p.m. Tuesday-Saturday but the East Side Trails entrance is open dawn to dusk every day.

The **Cope Environmental Center**, just west of Richmond, was established in 1992 when educators Jim and Helen Cope transformed their farm into a nature center with botanist, arborist, and conservationist Francis Park.

Program Coordinator Stephanie McCurdy says “Cope Environmental Center is full of opportunities for visitors of all ages to interact with nature.”

People visit primarily for the nature programs. “We encourage people to be active in nature—to touch, smell, even taste—the great outdoors to awaken and

discover their sense of wonder,” McCurdy explains. “When the natural world gives a benefit, and people are having fun with it, they learn to care for

“The No. 1 thing people like about the Arboretum is the hiking trails,” Hayes says. “Come run through the woods. Bring your dog.”

Long before woolly mammoths roamed the frozen plains, long before dinosaurs existed, Indiana was covered by a shallow sea flourishing with life. The fossils found in the area give us some idea of what life was like 445 million years ago. Fossils of snails, corals, trilobites, bivalves, brachiopods, bryozoa and others can be found among rock formations, along stream banks of the Whitewater Gorge Trail, or any place where nature and time have eroded them from the surrounding rock.

it and be good stewards.

We have 3 miles of hiking trails through habitats, prairies, and wetlands, an abundance of wildlife to be seen, and a natural playscape for the little ones to explore." Kids love the wetlands because 'they can go into the water to catch frogs.'

Cope's education building is a "living building" made from mostly local, sustainable, toxin-free and energy efficient materials. McCurdy states "it is an honor to continue to share the Cope Family's mission of conservation, education, research to promote sustainability. We invite people to visit and discover what Cope Environmental Center is all about."

As at Hayes Arboretum, admission to the trails at Cope is free.

The **American Discovery Trail**, with 6,800 miles of multi-use trail stretching from Delaware to California, goes through Wayne County. One of its local trails is the **Cardinal**



Greenway, Indiana's longest rail-to-trail covering 62 miles from Richmond to Marion. It goes through **Whitewater Gorge Park** as the **Whitewater Gorge Trail**.

In addition to part of the city, this urban trail passes local geology and history, taking in **Thistlethwaite Falls**, the **Starr-Gennett Logo building** and **Gennett Records** studio site and Musicians' Walk of Fame.

County and city parks offer additional trails in **Glen Miller Park**, **Springwood Park**, and **Middlefork Reservoir**. Earlham College and I.U. East invite walkers to their campuses.

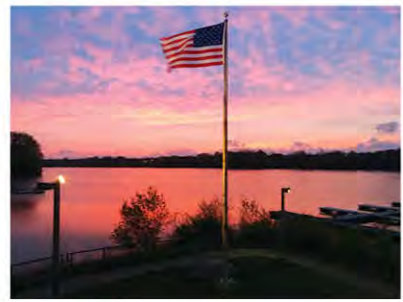

The **Tin Lizzie Café** is a quaint, cozy eatery located downtown Richmond serving home-style favorites for both breakfast and lunch.

Cinnamon Spice Bakery, on the west edge of Centerville, is a quick breakfast stop for coffee and doughnuts—unless the inviting atmosphere compels a respite at one of the small tables.

In Cambridge City, **Lumpy's Café's** signature dish is their giant hand-breaded tenderloin sandwich that's crisp on the outside and juicy on the inside. Just down the street, is **King's Café** where you'll find made-from-scratch cinnamon rolls, and a variety of desserts. Sandwiches, soups and salads are made fresh for the lunch crowd.



Little Sheba's opened as a sandwich shop in 1990. Since then it's grown into a restaurant & bar. The Sheba burger is the No. 1 seller; also popular are Italian subs, Greek pizza and Reubens. Altogether, more than 40 custom sandwiches.

On the next block, where Firehouse No. 1 was built in 1860, there's **Firehouse BBQ & Blues**. Fireman owner Tom Broyles loved the old building. He'd always been

interested in barbecue and appreciates Richmond's rich music history. So in 2012, his passions merged with the opening of Firehouse BBQ & Blues. The restaurant honors its firefighter past with murals, patches from fire stations throughout the country, and even a fireman's pole. Additional murals

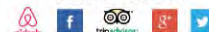

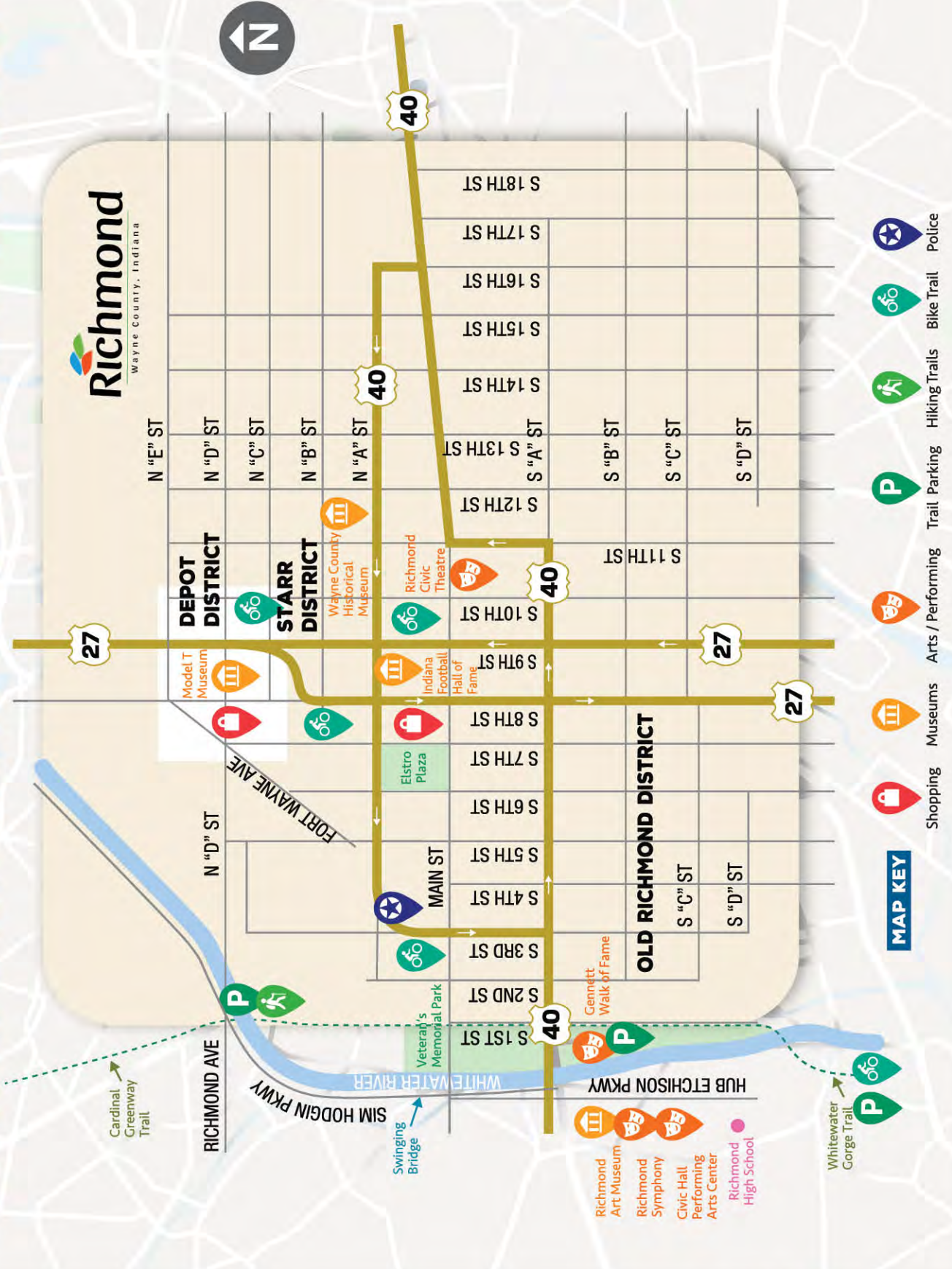

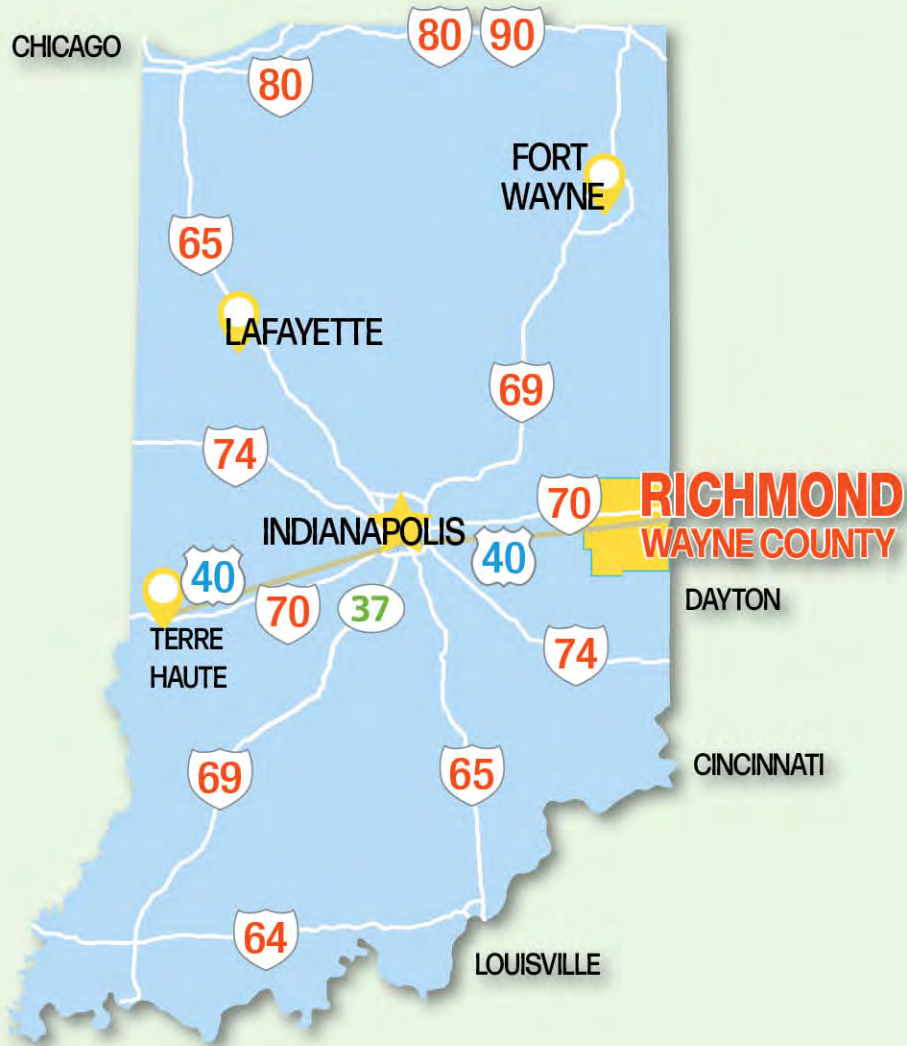
