# Firehouse BBQ & Blues

Situated in the heart of Richmond, this unique BBQ joint is in Richmond's oldest firehouse! The historic firehouse was transformed into a hub of BBQ greatness and blues by fireman Tom Broyles.

In addition to fire memorabilia throughout the building, including the original fire pole, the restaurant pays tribute to Richmond's deep connection to Blues. Richmond, Indiana, is the birthplace of recorded Jazz, and this music legacy is not forgotten. Live music is a common occurrence at Firehouse BBQ & Blues; check their schedule for upcoming performances.
