


Closed through mid-September 2025



WHAT TO EXPECT

- Construction will begin in mid-July to improve the I-70 and U.S. 40 interchange near Richmond.
- The ramps from eastbound and westbound I-70 to westbound U.S. 40 are expected to close the week of July 14 and reopen in mid-September.
- The official detour is S.R. 227 to U.S. 27 to westbound U.S. 40.
- During the closure, crews will remove existing pavement and begin roundabout construction at the interchange.

INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS

- Significant changes to the U.S. 40 interchange are expected to improve safety and mobility.
- The diamond interchange will be replaced with a single-lane roundabout with removal of the current loop ramps.
- Weaving movements from entrance and exit ramps will be eliminated.
- The reconstructed interchange will open by late 2027.
